Presentation of the candidate

Rositsa Dimitrova Becheva graduated from the High School of Music - Plovdiv in 1983 with a degree in piano. In 1990 she graduated with a Master's degree in Music Theory at the TCDF of the National Academy of Music "Pancho Vladigerov", and in 1997 she completed a postgraduate qualification with a degree in Music Pedagogy "at the Academy of Music and Dance - Plovdiv. In 2004 she successfully defended the educational and scientific degree "Doctor" in the scientific specialty - 05.08.02. Musicology and Music Art with a dissertation on "Methodology of teaching synthesizer". From 2000 to 2011 she was a part-time lecturer at New Bulgarian University, and from June 2011 she was a senior assistant - scientific specialty 05.08.02. Musicology and Music Art (synthesizer, computer music making, solfeggio) at the Music Department of New Bulgarian University.

Rositsa Becheva's research interests are in the field of electronic and computer music, computer music making and sound design. Her personal research program is focused on the application of new methods and forms of work in education, which are used in her work as a lecturer at New Bulgarian University. She develops her own teaching methodology, which seeks to improve the individual approach to working with students.

Dr. Becheva participates in the improvement and development of courses and programs at New Bulgarian University, in the preparation of textbooks for the courses, organizes author's training seminars, participates in the organization and implementation of workshops, concerts and projects of the Department of Music.

She organizes and conducts an author's seminar "Electronic musical interpretation"

within the permanent seminar "Musical sub-horizons" of the department "Music"; together

with Prof. Dr. Simo Lazarov organizes and participates in the seminar "Sound Design from A

to Z"; organizes and participates in the annual international forum-festival "The Universe of

Computer Music"; participates with reports and publications in the scientific conference of the

National Section of Acoustics and the Institute of Mechanics - BAS and the National

Scientific Conference FEMA, as well as in the Scientific Conference with international

participation for doctoral and postdoctoral students "Young Scientific Forum for Music and

Dance", organized by Department "Music" - New Bulgarian University. She has been a

member of the Musicologists Section of the Union of Bulgarian Composers since 2013.

She has won a number of awards:

- "Crystal Lyre" of UBM(TD) in the category "Sound and sound design";

- "Book of the Year" for "In the world of electronic music by Simo Lazarov" (2018);

- The "Golden music staff" of the Union of Bulgarian Composers;

As a habilitation thesis in the competition Rositsa Becheva has presented her book "In

the world of Simo Lazarov's electronic music" (Sofia: Publishing House of the New

Bulgarian University, 2018, ISBN: 978-619-233-011-8, 472 p.

The monograph was published by the New Bulgarian University with editor Prof. Dr.

Milena Shushulova and reviewers: Prof. Elisaveta Valchinova-Chendova, D. Sc, Prof. Dr

Georgi Arnaudov, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Boris Naimushin (translation and editing of content and

summary in English), Tanya Yordanova (design and pre-press), Petya Petkova -

Communications and Protocol Department, New Bulgarian University (author of part of the

photo material).

The book is dedicated to the 70th anniversary of Simo Lazarov, honorary professor

at New Bulgarian University and founder of the electronic music in Bulgaria and is a

comprehensive study of the creative path and the music of the composer with a deep

understanding of the creative process and at the same time, knowledge of the technological

means on which it is based.

Although the monograph focuses on the composer's creative activity, it is not

biographical in nature, but rather - a serious musical-theoretical development, which

brings to the fore the problems of electronic sound extraction and interpretation,

compositional system, ideas of timbre space, the idea of synthesis of the arts, the idea of

synthesis of the linguistic-semantic layers, the conceptual model for a synthetic

performance, the stylistic features of music, the creative approaches and decisions, the

evolution of ideas. The peculiarities of the digital performance, the integration of

electronics and computer technologies, the incorporation of multimedia in the performance

and the unconventional forms of presentation are clarified.

The research has a high scientific and applied value and can be used both in the

process of training in the field of electronic and computer music, as well as among a wider

range of specialists.

Indicator 5. Leading (individual) creative performance in the sphere of arts (8

activities 35 points each)

According to this indicator, Rositsa Becheva has presented a series of 8 activities

related to the popularization of her monograph "In the world of Simo Lazarov's electronic

music". The events are of a discussion nature and have been realized in various locations

in Sofia and Plovdiv, including as part of the radio show "Artefir", hosted by Nevena

Pramatarova.

meet the requirements for the indicator and are directly related to the thematic area of the

competition.
